Dear Friends,



It is my pleasure to present to you the 2018 Riverside Foundation Annual Report. This year we are focusing on our Riverside Family which is crucial to our success in providing quality programs and support to over 500 people since 1976. Our Riverside Family consists of everyone that makes this vibrant special needs community work. This includes our residents, our work and activity center clients, their family members and our staff. Our Board of Directors, Women's Board, volunteers and our generous donors also join with us to support our mission to empower the individuals we serve.

This past year we have been able to make significant improvements to our campus in Lincolnshire. A substantial donation allowed us to improve the safety of the parking lot and complete needed roof repairs. Other donations enabled us to purchase new dining room armchairs which increased the stability, comfort and dining pleasure for our residents. With additional funding, we have hired a full time Rehabilitation Aide to assist with our clients' mobility and to improve/maintain their ability to walk, transfer and move independently.

The obstacles Riverside and similar agencies throughout the state have faced in the past few years continue with more intensity. Severely inadequate state reimbursement, difficulty in hiring dedicated staff and keeping up with onerous state and federal regulations makes our mission extremely difficult as we look to the future. Plus, we continue to look to the State of Illinois to provide additional reimbursement and support to help agencies like Riverside develop and open additional small group homes because all people deserve to be part of a community.

As a member of our family, you are an integral part of the success and future of Riverside Foundation. We sincerely thank you for your past support and look forward to your future involvement.


Who We Are

It's Not Just a Residence. *It's Home.*

Riverside Foundation, a not for profit tax-exempt social service organization, is a vibrant special needs community for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Riverside provides professional intake assessment, individualized habilitation plans, structured activities designed to increase functional independence, 24 hour-a-day nursing support and programming to increase daily living community skills & social skills. Our program integrates social services, recreation, specialized therapies and medical services to meet our residents' physical, psychological and emotional challenges. Since 1976, Riverside has served and supported over 500 clients at our residential facility and campus located in Lincolnshire, Illinois.

At the residential facility, we focus on individual autonomy within an environment of professional care. Social interaction is offered through an assortment of activities and experiences. Some of our popular in house programs include pet therapy offered by Lincolnshire Animal Hospital, computer time, holiday dances, parties on the patio, arts and crafts, movie night, activity sessions with one of our volunteers and yoga classes. Residents have the opportunity to participate in community activities and enjoy trips to sporting events, summer camp, local parks, Stevenson High School dances, Boy Scout programs, Riverside's Annual Garden Walk, Chicago

museums, the Chicago Botanic Gardens and Lake Geneva. The residents also enjoy team outings, programs at the library, outings to fitness programs at LifeSport Athletic Club, movies, restaurants, coffee shops and shopping trips. Riverside Foundation offers the ability to build the residents' community while enhancing the development and independence of each individual.

Riverside's Expanding Residential Choices

Community Integrated Living Arrangements

Riverside Foundation has eagerly expanded its residential opportunities with the development of three Community Integrated Living Arrangements (CILAs). The CILA is a family-like arrangement that provides a supervised and supportive living environment and addresses individual preferences, abilities and needs. Each resident has their own bedroom, plans and prepares their meals and participates in neighborhood living. The group home setting allows independent living with assistance from staff in a safe environment.

Riverside currently has 12 residents living in CILAs. The Kenwood House, which opened in 2015, and Greentree House, which opened in 2017, are each home to four gentlemen. The Harvey House, which opened in 2016, is home to four women.

It is a pleasure to see the joy and the pride on the residents' faces as they speak of their home and accomplishments. They enthusiastically accept the responsibilities of daily living. Several of the residents work at Riverside's Work and Activity Center and several of the residents have transitioned to working in the community. Three of the men went through a Goodwill training program and work in the kitchen at Great Lakes Naval Base in North Chicago. They are pleased with the opportunity.

Riverside Foundation Work and Activity Center

Riverside Foundation's Work and Activity Center (RWA) has been an important part of Riverside since 1986. It enriches the lives of our residents as well as adults with developmental disabilities who reside in other settings. Our clients work according to their personal abilities and participate in meaningful activities and programs. RWA offers the opportunity to develop skills in an environment that emphasizes individual goals, good work habits and specific job skills.

RWA partners with local businesses, municipalities and organizations to help participants acquire skills, while providing an able work force. KSM, ITW, Total Promotions, Purdy Projects and CPA Chicago are some of RWA's customers. The services Riverside provides are bagging, collating, labeling, light assembly and disassembly, packaging and sorting. Riverside Work and Activity center offers an environment that fosters a sense of autonomy and self-worth through accomplishment and is a critical factor in pursuing happy, fulfilling lives.


