## **IDOT Grant:**

**New Vehicles, Greater Independence** 

We are proud to share that Riverside Foundation received three brand-new vehicles through an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) grant:

Two light-duty buses (each holding 14 passengers or up to 4 wheelchairs)

One handicap-accessible minivan (accommodates 6 passengers or 2 wheelchairs)


These additions will greatly enhance our transportation capabilities, helping residents access community events, appointments, and work opportunities with greater ease. A fourth vehicle—another accessible minivan—is expected soon. This \$365,000 grant is a vital investment in accessibility and independence.

- Encouraging participants in work activities




